# **2-** Working in the filed of National accounts and Balance of payments (Rest of the world accounts)<sup>1</sup>

Working in the Department of National Accounts in Palestine, and then director of this department until 2008 (it is necessary to point out that, in Palestine, two separate systems for national accounts compilation have been constructed: the primary system is for resident/resident transactions, and the secondary system is for resident/non-resident transactions – the latter are recorded in the so-called rest of the world account.), I built the national accounts in Palestine in accordance with the 1993 SNA, I supervised the compilation and collection of national accounts at current and constant prices and in the various economic ways, I produced short-term-indicators (quarterly accounts), and institutional accounts and the development of various methods of disseminating the national accounts in Palestine, in addition to that my contribution to the development of forms and ques. for collecting data for the economic surveys and national accounts. and I wish to refer to the following:

- The ability of building supply and use tables and input output tables.
- Building and designing all the files that related to the rest of the world account. (Travel files, Household files, labor force files, economic surveys files, Education and Health files and----etc).
- Foreign investment survey, including:
  - Designing and Developing Questionnaires
  - Preparing the work plan and budget for the survey.
  - Coordination to prepare the sample, methodology, and the preliminary file of the survey
  - Training fieldworkers staff.
  - Supervise the data-entry .
  - Extraction and analysis of the results.
  - Preparing the final results and reports.
  - Good experience in Planning, management and supervision of building official economic statistical programs (with applied experience as director of many statistical economic projects at PCBS).

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> When a central bank compiles the transactions between residents and non-residents, the account is generally referred to as a balance of payments. Even though the presentation and some classifications differ, the balance of payments is essentially the same account as the rest of the world

account. However, the balance of payments is essentially the same account as the rest of the world accounts, but the rest of the world account is an integral part of the latter.

In both the balance of payments and the rest of the world account, all transactions involving a resident and a non-resident entity should be recorded. Therefore, the main results are the same. However, there are some differences between the two accounts, the most important of which are:

<sup>1.</sup> In the balance of payments transactions are recorded from the perspective of residents, but the in the rest of the world account, they are recorded from the perspective of the rest of the world, i.e. non-residents. This implies that all entries recorded on the credit side in one account appear on the debit side in the other account and *vice versa*;

<sup>2.</sup> Some items that are recorded as services in the balance of payments (for example *travel*) are identified as goods in the rest of the world account;

<sup>3.</sup> Contrary to the balance of payments, there is no overall balance, and thus no distinction between *above-* and *below-the-line* items in the rest of the world account. The overall balance makes the balance of payments suitable for analysis of the external position of a country, whereas the rest of the world account is of a more descriptive nature.
